



Lambda Legacy Scholarship Fund

This fund awards scholarships to full-time students pursuing an undergraduate degree at University of Minnesota - Twin Cities. Scholarships will be awarded based on demonstrated academic achievement, and leadership roles within the fraternity at national or chapter level.

Scholarship Amount

One scholarship awarded in the amount of \$1,000.00 for the academic year 2017-2018.

Renewal Process

This is a one-time scholarship and is not renewable.

Eligibility Criteria

The eligible students must meet the following requirements:

- Full-time student pursuing an undergraduate degree at University of Minnesota - Twin Cities.
- Cumulative grade-point average no lower than 3.0.
- Must be an active member of the Beta Chi Theta National Fraternity.
- Leadership roles within the fraternity at national or chapter level.
- Must have documented minimum of 20 hours in community service (National Standard) during the previous academic year.
- Must have good financial standing with the Beta Chi Theta Chapter.

Requirements

The students interested in applying for the scholarship must submit the following:

- [Completed scholarship application](#).
- Two letters of recommendations - One from an alumnus of the Beta Chi Theta Fraternity, and another from the external community (teachers, guidance counselors, employers, mentors or community leaders).
- Unofficial college transcript marked as of Spring 2017.
- Most recent resume.
- Essay - applicant must submit the following two essays (max 1,000 words per essay):
 - Describe your career goals and steps you have taken to achieve them.
 - What is your single most greatest accomplishment and why?
